

COOKIES POLICY FOR THE SERVICE

The kuraCloud service uses cookies to distinguish you from other kuraCloud users. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse kuraCloud and also allows us to improve kuraCloud. By continuing to use the service, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These cookies are necessary to enable kuraCloud to operate efficiently so that visitors can navigate around with ease and use specific features. If these cookies are disabled, services that you subsequently request cannot be provided.
- **Analytical/performance cookies.** They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around kuraCloud when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way kuraCloud works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to kuraCloud. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).

You can find more information about the types of cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

Cookie	Host(s)	Purpose
Strictly necessary	kuraCloud	These cookies are essential in order for you to seamlessly navigate the kuraCloud service and use its features.
Analytical/performance	Google Analytics	Google Analytics cookies collect information in an anonymous form, providing service analytics and sales data. We can therefore determine where visitors have come from, how they are interacting with kuraCloud and how many visits have been recorded. These cookies assist with making ongoing improvements to the kuraCloud service and your online experience.
Functionality	kuraCloud	This cookie helps us to remember who you are from a previous visit so you do not need to re-enter the same information.

Please note that third parties (including, for example, advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services) may also use cookies, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies.

You block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including strictly necessary cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of the kuraCloud service.
